Located only 35 minutes north of Kitchener-Waterloo and 20 minutes from the picturesque town of Elora, the 375-seat Drayton Festival Theatre is a renovated 1902 Opera House, boasting wonderful acoustics. This historic building and former Town Hall has a rich history of entertaining audiences with the finest talent in professional theatre, including such legendary performers as Beatrice Lillie. Getting there offers a scenic drive through rolling farmland and quaint villages.

The Drayton Festival Theatre is wheelchair accessible. The box office, restrooms and refreshment area are all located on the main level.

Stage Specifications

The stage is located on the second floor of the Drayton Festival Theatre Building.

Proscenium width:	36'
Proscenium height:	15'
Total width of the stage:	47'8"
Depth of the stage:	25'

Fixed grid at 16'6" above the stage floor with grid pipes at 8" centres.

Loading: Dock use requires rental of a lift and a trained operator. There is a small elevator available to transport small, lightweight items to the orchestra level of the theatre.

Lighting

A basic lighting plot is provided with your rental which will be hung and circuited prior to your arrival. Changes to the basic plot can be accommodated.

Sound

Our sound system which includes main speakers, on stage monitors, mixing console and amplifiers, is suitable for theatrical and dance presentations as well as lectures and audio-visual presentations. Arrangements can be made for the rental of microphones and other audio equipment. An in-house professional sound operator is required to operate the sound system.

Dressing Rooms

Three dressing rooms are available, accommodating up to twenty-three people.

Box Office

Box Office service is available to all event producers. The box office will accept cash, cheque, Mastercard, Visa, American Express and Interac as payment for tickets. Ticket printing (general admission or reserved seating) includes set-up of the event in our computerized ticketing database. The box office is available by phone Monday 9am-5pm and Tuesday through Saturday 9am-9pm. For all events the box office will be open two hours prior to the event start time.
