Thou shall intersperse chaperones and students – no chaperones should sit together.

(When everyone pays attention, everyone has a good time.)

Thou shall not place feet on seat in front, or tap out rhythm.

(The back of the seat in front is not a drum and does not belong to you.)

Thou shall not go to and fro from thy seat during performance.

(This disrupts the show for everyone.)

Thou shall not remove the name plaques from seat arms.

(These are not trophies to take home.)

Thou shall turn off all that goes beep, ring or buzz.

(Accompaniment provided by the orchestra only.)

Anyone who does not comply with the 10 Commandments will be asked to leave the theatre.

Everyone has the right to a pleasant theatre experience.

Please respect the performers, theatre, and other audience members.
