JOB DESCRIPTION / DUTIES

Drayton Entertainment is searching for a candidate to fill the seasonal position of House Technician – Drayton Festival Theatre for the 2022 summer season. **The contract will start May 23, 2022 and finish on September 4, 2022.**

The House Technician will:

- Hang & Focus lighting for all shows at the Drayton Festival Theatre
- Load-in & fit-up scenery as required
- Run shows as stage crew and/or spot operator as assigned
- Liaise with stage management teams and Facility Manager / Front of House staff to complete repairs as required
- Participate in season site prep, changeovers, & load-outs
- Follow all Health and Safety policies, and advise the supervisor of any safety concerns throughout the season

From time to time, other duties may be assigned as required. This may include working at alternate worksites, and different schedules. Advance notice will be given for any changes to established working hours and locations.

QUALIFICATIONS / REQUIRED SKILLS:

- Work experience and training in Technical Theatre Production with a focus on those skills described above
- Good interpersonal skills and a team player
- Working at heights
- Ability to lift up to 50lbs
- Previous experience programming ETC lighting consoles would be an asset
- Valid G Driver's License would be an asset
